ABOUT THE GEORGIA ASTA CAMP

The Georgia American String Teachers Association Summer Orchestra Camp is held at the Calvin Center in Hampton, Georgia. It is a comprehensive orchestra curriculum for students in grades 4-9. Georgia ASTA developed this camp to encourage young string players as they discover the fun and rewards of making music together.



THE FACILITIES

Camp Calvin is located 30 minutes from downtown Atlanta. Housing and most rehearsals are located in the Conference Lodge. For larger camps, the nearby Geneva Lodge is used for housing as well. All meals are served cafeteria-style just a short walk from the Conference Lodge, and include a full salad bar and many healthy options at every meal.



RECREATIONAL ACTIVITIES

A variety of recreational activities are offered daily, including lifeguard-supervised pool time, a camp fire, hayride, ice cream social, and movies.
